President Duane Teter called the regular meeting of the Southwest Public Schools Board of Education to order at 7:35 p.m. on March 11, 2013 at the Southwest Junior-Senior High School in Bartley.

Superintendent Waddle discussed the February 20 external school improvement visit and their recommendation for accreditation and suggestions along with praise for the steering committee , the updated schedule for completion of the gym renovation project, the installation of water to the shop area which was outside the scope of the renovation project, superintendent transition, and the NRCSA Spring Conference on March 21 and 22 in Kearney.

Principal Springer reported on senior graduation and scholarships, track and football field plans, class schedules for 2013-2014, aligning the science and math curriculum, and the importance of MAPS testing.

Principal Rasmussen reported on kindergarten orientation, pre-kindergarten applications, elementary quiz bowl host, enthusiasm and implementation of the science curriculum, complements from the external school improvement visit, student preparation for MAPS testing, and upcoming events.
